Guidance

In June 2020 the government announced £1 billion of funding to support children and young people to catch up on missed learning caused by coronavirus (COVID19). This is especially important for the most vulnerable pupils and pupils from disadvantaged backgrounds who we know have been most affected.

EEF Recommendations

To support schools to make the best use of this funding, the Education Endowment Fund (EEF) has published a <u>COVID-19 Support Guide for</u> <u>Schools</u>. Every school will have been affected by COVID-19 differently and the right way to support pupils will differ between schools and must be informed by the professional judgements of teachers and school leaders. For many pupils, compensating for the negative impact of partial school closures will require a sustained response. It is highly unlikely that a single approach will be enough.

The guidance recommends strategies in the following categories:

- \rightarrow Targeted Approaches
- \rightarrow Wider Strategies
